
These #1 and #2 bottles and jugs now go in your commingle recycle bin



the items shown above. #1 and #2 bottles and jugs can now go into your commingle recycle bin. We will not accept either of those items.

Please Note:

We cannot accept items that do not meet this criteria.



- ⇒ Items **must** be stamped 23 243 253 and presorted by BOTH shape and number
- ⇒ Items **must** be totally clean and dry
- ⇒ Items **must** be free of all labels and stickers that are not printed on. No sticky residue

Tips for Proper Preparation of Plastics for Collection Event

- Items will be screened and rejected if they don't meet the criteria. The company that recycles them won't accept them otherwise.
- Items **must** be clean and free of debris or they will be returned to you.
- Items **must** have a resin code. 23 43 25



- Labels that are "heat stamped" are ok to leave. However, if you can peel up a corner of the label at all, it needs to be removed. Soak in water or rub with cooking oil and let soak overnight. It's then easier to remove them the next day.
- Trays are acceptable if they meet all the other criteria.
- Bottles and jugs with #2 are now accepted in your commingle bin, or at the Lane County Transfer Station. We will not be collecting them and they will be returned to you.
